NO LIMITS missions include:

- Serving food
- Opening a gate
- Playing ball
- Reading bus route signs
- Pushing in chairs
- Picking a CD up off the floor
- Feeding pets
- Removing glasses
- Climbing stairs

FLL teams will:

- Examine seemingly simple tasks in a new light and explore how technology and human thought can work together to create access for all
- Build and program a robot that addresses the specific needs of people who face physical challenges in today's society
- Research and present robotics technology solutions to help individuals in their community perform activities of daily living that many people take for granted
