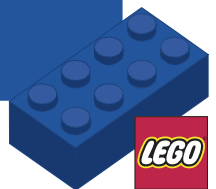
FLL: 2005 OCEAN ODYSSEY

- Responsible fishing
- Preventing pollution
- Recovering valuables
- Locating a sunken ship
- Repairing an underwater line



FLL teams will:

- **Dive** headfirst into one of the last great under-explored frontiers
- **Build** and program a robot to accomplish aquatic missions in a fun team environment
- **Research** and present technological opportunities and novel thinking to help understand and solve mounting problems in the oceans
